
Cambridge High School's Black History Month Door Decoration Contest

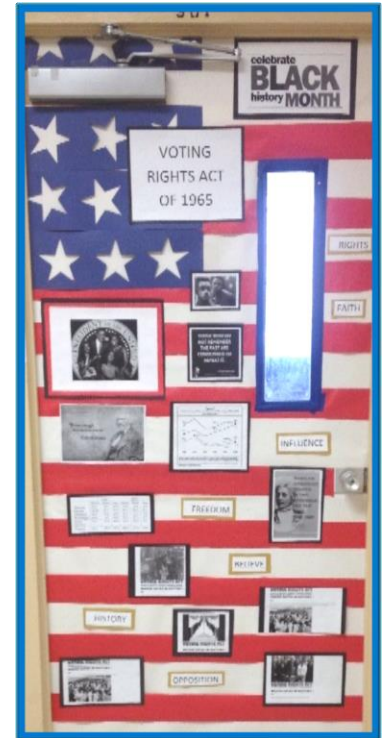

 - World Languages-International Figures or Events
 - Fine Arts-Artists of Various Mediums or Events
 - Study Hall or PAWS:
 - Theme Focused
 - *Celebrating Freedom, Equality, Diversity and Pride*
- Must send a sketch or sample of your ideas to Mr. Maize before you decorate the door (Drop off or Email: Maize@fultonschools.org) All sample submissions are due by Thursday, February 09, 2017
- All decorations should be on the outside of the door
- Decorations are NOT allowed to cover ALL of the window on the door. Must be able to see into the classroom.
- Decorations should be securely fastened to the door
- Decoration should not permanently change the door (everything that is attached should be detachable when the contest is over)

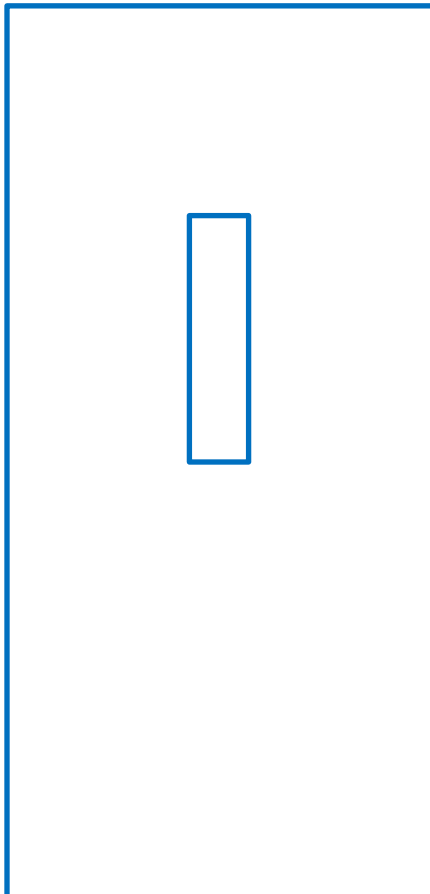
