8. Based on the Platt Amendment, what can you infer America's viewpoint about Cuba's independence?	9. Review the 5 goals of imperialism. Do you think participating in imperialism is necessary to protect a nation's border or is it driven by nationalism, greed and/or wealth?
10. What lasting political, social and economic impact did imperialism at the end of the 19 th Century and the turn of the 20 th Century have on American society?
