1. Enumerated-Federal powers listed in Constitution
  - Declare war
  - Create a post office
  - Coin money
  - Create and fund military
2. Reserved-Powers not listed for national government and individuals belong to the state
  - Regulate intra state trade
  - Public education
  - Regulate alcohol
  - Pass license requirements for professional
3. Concurrent-Powers shared between state and national government
  - Levy taxes
  - Claim private property for public use
  - Create criminal system
